

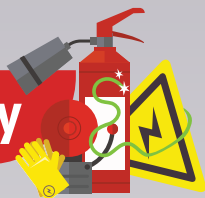

Does your child wear warm, waterproof boots especially in rainy and snowy days?

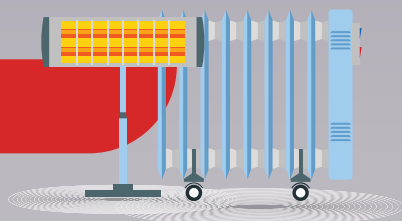
Do you remove drawstrings from clothing that could catch on climbing or play equipment especially for young kids?
